### II. SCOPE OF WORK

- A. Our Proposal Includes
  - 1. Inspection and License fees
  - Disconnect existing Generators at each location. (2201 109<sup>th</sup> Street, SH 161 & Marshall Dr., 501 E. Camp Wisdom)
  - Disconnect existing ATS's at each location. (2201 109th Street, SH 161 & Marshall Dr., 501 E. Camp Wisdom)
  - Install new 50kw Cummins Generator at 2201 109<sup>th</sup> Street location with new 225amp ATS Nema 3r outdoor enclosure.
  - 5. Provide and install New Concrete pad for new Generator at 2201 109<sup>th</sup> Street.
  - Provide and install new underground 3" & 1" conduit with feeder and control wire to generator at 2201 109<sup>th</sup> Street.
  - 7. Install new 50kw Cummins Generator at SH161 & Marshall Dr. with new 225amp ATS Nema 3r outdoor.
  - 8. Provide and install chain-link gate in front of outdoor ATS to achieve proper clearance at SH161 & Marshall location.
  - 9. Provide and install new feeder wire at SH161 & Marshall location.
  - 10. Install new 50kw Cummins Generator at **501 E. Camp Wisdom** with new 225amp Nema 1 ATS.
  - 11. Provide and Install new feeder wire at 501 E. Camp Wisdom location.
  - 12. Each New Generator and ATS will be equipped with DDC connection capabilities coordinated with Environmatics scope listed below:
    - a. Tie in to existing Reliable Controls front end

- b. Set up of trend logs for all inputs and set up of runtime logs
- c. Onsite owner training
- d. 1 year warranty
- e. Dedicated Reliable controller for Cummings generator
- f. All required control cable and installation
- g. Static IP router, remote alarming via text/email, complete graphics package per owner's requirements
- MODBUS communications interface to generator and ATS. If ATS does not have MODBUS, we will monitor the dry contact alarms
- Control enclosure with UPS to keep system online during power transfer
- j. Control of (2) wall-pack AC units via dedicated DDC controller
- k. All required control cable and installation
- I. Monitor space temperature
- m. Monitor supply air temperature
- n. Monitor fan status via current switch

#### B. Clarifications

- Controls scope: the proposal includes all conduits, pathways, coring, trenching, and any other work required to get cable from the generator and ATS to inside the building.
- Wall pack unit controls scope is for monitoring ONLY and does not include control of the units.
- 3. Owner to provide a list of the MODBUS points that are needed for monitoring for configuration of the MODBUS profile.
- 4. Owner to provide a dedicated static IP address for remote communication to each site.
- 5. Existing Generators and ATS's will be taken to the City of Grand Prairie Service Center.
- 6. Demolition includes disconnecting and making safe for removal.
- 7. Brandt will provide assistance for testing of monitoring equipment by Environmentics.
- 8. This proposal is valid for 30 days
- 9. This proposal is based on copper at the current level of \$ 2.43 lb. and pricing may be adjusted based on copper levels at time of award.
- 10. Payment and performance bond.

## III. Exclusions

- 1. Overtime
- 2. Utility company charges
- 3. Cutting or patching of concrete, masonry, brick, etc.
- Placing or forming of concrete (i.e., housekeeping pads, curbs, pole bases, transformer pads, handholes, etc.) Except 2201 109<sup>th</sup> Street location
- 5. Cutting or patching of sheetrock, plaster, etc.
- 6. Painting or priming of any kind
- 7. Warranty of existing electrical work
- 8. Business interruptions or losses resultant there from
- 9. Consequential damages
- 10. Generator disposal.
- 11. Lightning protection system
- 12. Permit and inspection fees
- 13. Generator exhaust piping, Fuel Piping and venting.
