# RE: Cedar Creek Culvert Improvements at Robinson Road and Prairie Lane

Mr. Khavari,

On January 15, 2013, bids were opened for the above referenced project. Eight (8) contractors submitted bids for this project. All bidders acknowledged receipt of the issued addenda and submitted bid bonds.

The low bidder for this project is Humphrey & Morton Construction Company, Inc. with a total base bid of \$571,993.70 and a total alternate bid of \$621,640.30.

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A summary of the number of bids is provided in the table below:

AECOM checked the bids for errors and omissions and found one error was made by A&M Construction and Utilities, Inc. in the base bid, which was off by \$31,200 against their favor, and two errors in the added alternate bid which was off by \$2,240 in their favor; however, their ranking remained in fourth position out of eight bids.

Also, SYB Construction Co., Inc. base bid was misread during bid announcement as \$681,409.30 in lieu of the contract base bid of \$867,887.30.

The low bid was submitted by Humphrey & Morton Construction Company, Inc. with a total base bid of \$571,993.70 and a total alternate bid of \$621,640.30.

The Oak Grove Gardens Drainage Construction project, constructed in 2012, included a direct drive, cast-in-place culvert with wingwalls and a roadway.

Mr. Fernell stated that Humphrey & Morton Construction is a great contractor. They performed good work in a timely fashion. They also performed cleanup very well and had great public relations throughout the project.

The Pipe Line Road Reconstruction project, constructed in 2012, included box culvert, inlet, concrete paving, headwalls and wingwalls.

Mr. Weiss stated that Humphrey & Morton Construction did a good job. The City had no issues and the schedule was met with no drainage type delays. H&M performed the culvert improvements and subcontracted out the roadway work.

#### **Recommendation:**
