-This occupancy condition shall include buildings in which there are any person receiving custodial care who require limited verbal or physical assistance while responding to an emergency situation to complete building evacuation

Mayberry Gardens intends to obtain a license with Texas Health and Human Services.

Mayberry Gardens complies with this verbage and does not provide care for residents in its Alzheimer's home who are bed ridden or who require more than limited verbal or physical assistance to evacuate or who needs services comparable to those services available in a nursing home. Mayberry Gardens also currently complies and will comply with licensing regulation §92.5 Health Care Professional which states:

§92.5 Health Care Professional

(a) A health care professional may coordinate the provision of services to a resident within the professional's scope of practice and as authorized under Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 247, however, a facility must not provide ongoing services to a resident that are comparable to the services available in a nursing facility licensed under Texas Health and Safety Code, Chapter 242.
