New State Electrical Legislation regulating fees and adoption of the National Electrical Code

# State Legislation affecting Electrical Fees and Code Adoption

- HB3329 prohibits a municipality from collecting a licensing, registration or administrative fee from a state licensed *electrician*.
- *However, the last sentence in the statute does allow the municipality to issue building permits for “electrical work”.*
- *State Adoption of the 2017 National Electrical Code*

# FEES

- Current Fees

- Registration fees are as follows:

- Electrical Contractor \$75 (Yr)

- Master Electrician \$25 (Yr)

- Total \$100

- Electrical Permit

- Fee \$50

# Electrical

- Proposal:

- 1) To comply with the State we propose eliminating the Registration fees similar to what we did with the Plumbing registration fees.
- 2) Only issue permits to licensed electrical contractors and homeowners
- 3) We propose deleting an antiquated fee structure for electrical fees and raise our Building Permit fee for electrical work from \$50 to \$60 similarly to what we did to comply with the Plumbing License Law
- 4) Adopt the 2017 National Electrical Code by reference along with the NTCOG recommended amendments
